Because I go "behind enemy lines" to win souls, it is a war (II Cor. 10:3), but **JESUS** always tips the scales in our favor. Yes & amen!!!

My Omega Man Radio Internet show has been an anointed time of 2-hour ministry that goes to 167 countries. Brother Shannon Ray Davis is an awesome & powerful host. My twice a month Bible Study at Gloria Muscarella's beautiful home has averaged 30 or more. It is the encouraging **WORD** of **GOD** that brings them every other Monday.

I was blessed to go back home to Pittsburgh, PA (Steeler Nation) where I was born & raised. Pastor Frank Rocco, an anointed, powerful man of **GOD** invited me to be a guest speaker at "The Church" on May 14th — am & pm services. There is a lot of love & prayers that envelope me there.

My precious Brother Robert drove 6 hours to spend time with me & we stayed with our Aunt Meleva. I also prayed with some relatives & friends who are going thru major challenges. I always encourage those I pray for that "Prayer invades the impossible." (Luke 1:37; Jer. 32:17 & 27). I missed my Aunt Mildred & Uncle Walter who recently went home to the **LORD**.

Skid Row services were very well attended, with nice harvests of souls. There are so many walking

wounded youths there from drugs. These troubles that I see people go thru on Skid Row & Prisons breed "Soul Sickness." It is caused by a flood of troubles coming upon you. **NOT** just one problem, but one after another. In Ps. 69:1-3, King David cried, "Save me, **O'GOD**, for the waters are come into my soul. I sink in deep mire. I am come into deep waters — floods overflowing. I am weary of my crying." (Ps. 56:8).

Trouble came at David so powerfully he thought he would collapse. He prayed, "Be gracious to me, O'Lord, for I am distressed. I am wasting away from grief. My strength fails; my soul & my belly. (Ps. 31:9). I am speaking to those who are facing a flood of fears, (II Tim. 1:7). Fear & faith cannot live in the same heart (Isa. 41:10).

As you talk with people, listen as they express their hearts: sickness over the hell breaking out in schools; the political correct messages dumped on kids; teachings that are so immoral & godless, it sickens the soul. Parents grieve over children being drawn away by drug & alcohol addicted friends. Others have mounting bills piling up or troubled marriages (**THE GRASS IS NOT GREENER ON THE OTHER SIDE**). What are you facing in life as you read this? (I Peter 5: 6, 7).

The root cause of Soul Sickness is when the troubles go on — & even gets worse. Your soul cries out to **GOD** for help — & there seems to be no answer. Soul Sickness is to know the **LORD**, to love **HIM**, to pray & still **GOD** does **NOT** seem to be there, **BUT** He is. (Heb. 13:5; Matt. 28:20)

David said his troubles got so overwhelming, that his "soul was cast down, I cannot speak." Meaning, "I have cried so much, there are **NO** tears left. All I see now is despair in the days ahead." It is crucial to **KEEP** on **PRAYING**. (Luke 18:1). **GOD** will answer, in **HIS** time, in ways you cannot conceive. The hardest part of **FAITH** is the last half hour just before the answer comes. (II Cor. 4:16). And don't get mad at **GOD**, **NOT EVER!**

HE loves you thru **ALL** your struggles. **HE** is your loving, forgiving, compassionate, almighty & caring **FATHER**. Shake off fear (Ps. 27:1), because fear has torment. Rest in **HIS** promises. (II Cor. 1:20). Things may change, "but **GOD** will work all things together for good, to them that **LOVE GOD** & those who are called according to **HIS** purpose." (Romans 8:28) Look **UP** & you'll bump into **GOD** (Ps. 3:3). **GOD** will never fail you. (Acts 16:31)

YOUR ASSIGNMENT WILL REQUIRE A MIRACLE

Everyone has an assignment from God — something He has called you to do.

God never gives you an assignment that does not require His participation. So, your assignment will always be big enough to require a miracle. When Joshua and the Israelites approached the massive walls of Jericho, it took a miracle to bring the walls down (Joshua 6). When Naaman dipped in the muddy Jordan River to receive his cleansing from Leprosy, it took a miracle for his healing to occur (II Kings 5:14). When the widow of Zarephath was eating her last meal, it required a miracle for it to multiply. The harvest from her seed of obedience fed herself, Elijah and her son for the duration of the famine (I Kings 17:14-16).

Any assignment from God will require the miracles of God (Mal.3:6; Heb.13:8). So, feed your faith (II Cor. 5:7). It will always enter your heart when you hear the words of God. "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God," (Romans 10:17).

Your assignment may require supernatural financial provision. Miracles come to the obedient (I Sam. 15:22). Remember, Peter experienced the miracle of catching a fish with a coin in its mouth to pay Jesus' taxes. Financial miracles are normal in the lives of those who obey God. You will be tested, (Prov. 17:3; Rev. 2:23) but God is faithful! From time to time we all need financial miracles and God has always come through! (Phil. 4:19) Jesus loved performing miracles. When He talked, each word was an invitation to a miracle, & He is called the "Word of God." (Rev. 19:13)

God will never involve Himself in a dream that you can achieve alone (John 15:5). He makes miracles necessary so that you will be motivated to pursue Him and His involvement in your life. Every single act of God is designed to increase your dependency upon Him and addiction to His Presence. He will also include others to help you! Here is where you come in! Either you have a vision to do something for God or your assignment is to link up with someone with a vision! I have a vision to reach out to multitudes of people with the Gospel, not only on Skid Row & Prisons, but anywhere & everywhere. I am asking you to pray for me & the ministry God called me to do **DAILY**. All of our assignments wind up being connected to each other. That is why I pray for other ministries to fulfill their assignments!

Our assignment will always require the supernatural interventions of God. Remember: You want a miracle...or you are a candidate for a miracle... God wants a relationship. Miracles are moving toward you or away from you every day of your life. You are never as far from a miracle as it first appears. Never give up! (Luke 18:1; II Cor. 4:16). God hears **EVERY** prayer of the believer! (Prov. 15:29).
